REVISED HEALTH, SAFETY & ENVIRONMENT (HSE) ORIENTATION AND WHARF PASS PROTOCOLS

The Port of Port of Spain (PPOS) wishes to inform all its users that our Wharf Pass, and Health, Safety and Environment Protocols have changed:

- All users (Customers, Suppliers, Guests and Contractors) are required to complete the HSE Port Access Permit Form and the HSE Safety Orientation to apply for a Port Police Wharf Pass.
- The HSE Port Access Permit Form and the HSE Safety Orientation can be accessed online at PPOS's website at www.patnt.com>quicklinks.
- At the end of the online HSE Safety Orientation, you will be required to complete an online
 HSE examination. All questions in the HSE examination must be answered correctly in order
 to qualify for the Wharf Pass.
- 4. Upon successful completion of the HSE Safety Orientation examination and the HSE Port Access Permit Form, visitors will be granted HSE Clearance by the next business day.
- 5. After HSE clearance has been granted, successful applicants can proceed to the Wharf Pass Office to apply for their Wharf Pass. Port Police Wharf Pass Office business hours are Monday to Friday 7am to 4pm.

NOTE: Any HSE Orientation Cards issued before the 26th of February, 2022 remains valid until the expiry date. The issuance of a Wharf Pass after the 26th of February 2022 means that the holder has successfully completed, agreed to and understands the importance of Health and Safety Compliance on the Port Authority's compound. The Wharf Pass will now replace the existing HSE Orientation Cards with immediate effect.
