Repairs to Ship to Shore Crane 003

The Port of Port of Spain (PPOS) wishes to advise that our Liebherr Ship to Shore Crane (STS 003) will be removed from service on Sunday 3rd July, 2022 and is scheduled to return to service by Monday 15th August, 2022.

These works are necessary to improve the crane's reliability and performance that will serve to ensure continued efficient service to our stakeholders.

During this downtime, every effort will be made to limit operational disruption and we will continue to work with Shipping Lines and Pilots to ensure minimal vessel berthing interruptions. PPOS regrets any inconvenience that may arise due to these necessary repairs.

Please note that Ship to Shore Cranes 1, 4, and 5 would be available to service vessels. Additionally, the Port's Gottwald Mobile Harbour Crane (MHC002) is also operational and would be deployed if needed.
