## PROCEDURAL REQUIREMENTS AT THE PORT OF PORT OF SPAIN

Please be guided by the following procedural requirements at the Port of Port of Spain:

- 1. Templates of Letters of Authorisation which are to be presented to the Cargo Accounts Office : can be found on our website <u>http://www.patnt.com/cargo\_handling.php?mid=71</u>
- 2. Application process for a Wharf Pass <u>http://www.patnt.com/content/535.pdf</u>
- 3. Customs Brokers/Clerks and Apprentices are required to have the following when effecting the delivery of cargo at the Spectrum Facility:
  - Clearly displayed valid Wharf Pass.
  - Clearly displayed valid Customs Broker's/Clerk's Identification.
  - Bill of Lading and any other related shipping documents which have been approved by Customs & Excise and processed by the Port Authority of Trinidad and Tobago.
  - Release Order from Customs and Excise Division.
  - Delivery Note from the Port Authority of Trinidad and Tobago.
  - Copy of PATT Store Rent Invoice.
  - Copies of valid PATT Wharf Pass, valid Customs Broker's/Clerk's Identification and Letter of Authorization which has been approved at the Cargo Accounts Office.
